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

#### Hello Members

A keen cohort of drivers turned up under bleak and cloudy skies for our first meeting back at Lakeside in 2025 For the first time in over five years (before COVID) we conducted the drivers' briefing indoors. The start of our track activities was delayed for half an hour, then the rain passed, the track dried out and with the usual words of caution we got underway. Eventually all 54 entrants who wanted the expected 4 rounds got their full track time.

We had some special guests to observe our Club in action, and we had plenty of volunteers who took the group of high school girls for passenger laps to experience the thrill of a race track. The girls are part of their school's extension program, building an open wheeler to compete in a series (similar to the University SAE competition). John Tetley is supporting this initiative as part of Lakeside Park's community engagement program.

Unfortunately, we did have three incidents throughout the day. Two cars connected with the walls, at separate times, before Hungry Corner and we had to stop to clean up an oil spill that occurred in the Green Group. The LP medical team was quickly on the scene of each collision but neither driver required attention.

Once again, it is a reminder that driving on a race track, even at a non-competitive meeting like GEAR, still involves risk.

Please consider driving out to Morgan Park for our April track day. This venue is growing in popularity with members, with many arriving on Wednesday evening. The day is efficiently run by Jonno and his team of volunteers, and you can expect plenty of track time. It may be a little bit further to travel for some, but I have found it well worth the effort. If you can't enter, just come out for a country drive, enjoy the fresh air, and join us for a coffee, morning tea, or even lunch.

### VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY CATEGORIES

#### **ELIGIBLE CATEGORIES:**

- A. Production sedans and sports cars that are able to satisfy Qld Transport Special Vehicle Concession Scheme for Classic Vehicle eligibility Guidelines. The applicable guidelines are for historic vehicles that are at least 30 years old. Run-on models may be considered depending upon their conformance to the included models. Excludes vehicles fitted with later model, forced-induction engine of a larger capacity than original, unless it is certified with a QT Modification Plate. Excludes motorcycle powered vehicles unless original powerplant. Final decision on suitability of vehicle rests with the GEAR Committee.
- **B**. Clubman cars manufactured up to, and including, 2000, but excluding all Clubman cars with forced-induction or other departures from the Clubman concept.
- **C**. Open wheelers and sports racing cars manufactured up to, and including, 2002, but excluding all cars with carbon-fibre suspensions or motorcycle engine powered.
- **D**. Replicas and reproduction vehicles faithful in size, shape and major mechanical specifications of cars of the same era as category A, B, C above.
- **E**. Special interest vehicles with provenance or significant race history up to 1990, which may fit outside the categories of A to D above.


